

# 2017 PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DEADLINE: FRIDAY, APRIL 3, 2017 4 P.M.

The New River Community and Technical College Presidential Scholarship is a merit-based scholarship for current graduating high school seniors. The scholarship is designed to provide full in-state tuition for up to four (4) consecutive semesters beginning with fall (excludes summer terms and special sessions). Recipients must enter in the fall semester to redeem this scholarship and register for 12 or more credit hours pursuing a Certificate of Applied Science (C.A.S.) or as a degree-seeking student (A.S., A.A.S.). The recipient must remain enrolled in 12 or more credit hours each semester, register consecutively each fall and spring semesters and maintain an overall 3.0 GPA for the scholarship to remain applicable. Fees and books are not covered by the scholarship. - ✓ Must be a current high school senior in good standing, graduating in 2017 from a West Virginia public or private high school recognized by the WV Department of Education
- ✓ Must have an overall high school GPA of 3.0, verified by current unofficial transcript submitted with application
- ✓ Promise Scholarship and Health Sciences and Technology Academy (HTSA) Scholarship recipients are not eligible as full tuition is paid.
