

# 19th Annual West Virginia Lions Youth Camps and Exchange Scholarship Contest

## **Rules and Procedures**

## A. Objectives

- To serve the first objective of Lionism: "To create and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world."
- To encourage West Virginia youth to experience cultures of other countries by cultural youth exchange arranged by Lions, which includes a 4-6 week stay with one or more host families and may include a youth camp.
- To encourage West Virginia families to host youth from other countries through the Lions International Youth Camps and Exchange program.

#### B. Winners Receive:

At least three applicants will receive \$1500 travel grants. Others may be awarded if funds are available.

The selection committee will also name one alternate. In the event a winner chooses not to participate, the alternate will receive a \$ 1500 travel grant.

# <u>Please note that travel grants will not cover all your trip expenses or camp costs.</u>

- C. Eligibility All youth fulfilling the following conditions are encouraged to enter the scholarship contest:
  - Enrolled in high school or home study, grades 10-12, or a recent graduate.
  - Age 16-21 years of age by June 1 of the next calendar year.
  - A resident of West Virginia.

Please note that students who do not win a travel grant may still participate in the Lions Youth Camps and Exchange Program, at their own expense. However, the Youth Exchange Committee may award \$500 travel grants to these students if funds are available.

D. Contest Time Frame-The Scholarship Contest begins on September 1 and ends on November 15. Entries must be postmarked by November 15<sup>th</sup>. Email entries are not accepted. Youth will be asked to come for interviews at a central location in early-December for final selection.

#### F. Restrictions:

- If a youth has previously won a travel grant (other than a \$500 grant) through this program, he/she is not eligible to enter again.
- The youth and parents will agree to conform to the WV Lions Youth Camps and Exchange Programs rules as set forth herein.
- Travel grant funds may only be used in connection with a Lions youth exchange.
- Exchange trips take place between mid-June and mid-August.

### **G**. Youth Responsibilities:

- During the overseas exchange, winning youth should be prepared to speak in English for 15-30 minutes to a local Lions Club about themselves, life in the US and in West Virginia, and his/her experiences thus far.
- After the trip, the youth should be prepared to make a brief presentation to the sponsoring Lions club or another club near his/her community.
- During the exchange, youth should be prepared to act as a representative of their community, West Virginia and the USA and to abide by the host family customs and rules as well as that of any youth camp attended.

#### Other information:

All youth who plan to travel as exchangers must obtain a passport, at their own expense, if they do not already have one. Travel insurance IS REQUIRED. In addition, YOUTH EXCHANGERS AND FAMILY MUST AGREE TO COMPLETE A TYPED APPLICATION INORDER TO PARTICIPATE, which must include a passport size photo of the youth, a photo of the youth's family, and a brief letter of introduction to the prospective host family. Host family arrangements are made in the spring, and trips take place from mid-June to mid-August and last 4-6 weeks. One or more host families and a youth camp may be part of the trip. Italy requires a camp in addition to staying with a host family. THIS APPLICATION MUST BE POSTMARKED BY November 15, 2014. Please send to Lion Sue Via, P O Box 37 Union, West Virginia, 24983.
