

Resident Program - \$6,000 Maximum -



### Get an A

Earn \$25 for each A in a Core course (up to \$375 maximum).



### Maintaining a high GPA

Earn \$25 per credit (up to 20 credits) for each 0.1 points above a 3.5 GPA (up to \$1,875 maximum).



#### Take an AP or IB course

Earn \$50 for each AP or IB course (up to \$500 maximum).



### **Eagle Scout**

Earn \$100 for receiving the honor, Eagle Scout, from Boy Scouts of America (up to \$100 maximum).



#### Gold Award

Earn \$100 for receiving the honor, Gold Award, from Girl Scouts of America (up to \$100 maximum).



### Score well on the PSAT (Math and Reading) or PreACT

Earn \$150 for a PSAT score of at least 105 (Math and Reading) (or new PSAT equivalent), or a PreACT score of at least 19 (for a maximum award of \$150).



## Score well on the SAT I (Math and Reading) or ACT

Earn \$1,000 for a SAT score of 1100 (Math and Reading) then \$40 for each additional 10 points (or new SAT equivalent), or \$1,000 for an ACT score of 22 then \$145 for each additional point, whichever is higher.



### Attend an Off-Campus Event

Earn \$50 for an off-campus event with West Virginia University (up to \$50 maximum).



## Attend a Summer Program

Earn \$100 for attending a summer program at West Virginia University (up to \$100 maximum).



### Visit our Campus

Earn \$200 for a campus visit to West Virginia University (up to \$200 maximum).



### Take an Honors or Advanced course

Earn \$25 for each Honors or Advanced course (up to \$250 maximum).



### Complete a Financial Avenue course

Earn \$50 for completing a Financial Avenue financial literacy course through West Virginia University (up to \$50 maximum award).



## Complete an ACCESS or Dual Enrollment course

Earn \$50 for completing an ACCESS course through West Virginia University (up to \$150 maximum award).



#### 4-H Member

Earn \$100 for being a 4-H member.



#### Complete the FAFSA

Earn \$50 for completing the FAFSA in your senior year.

# Ongoing Requirements

Once Enrolled in College

To maintain financial aid once enrolled, students must maintain a 2.75 GPA for the first year and a 3.0 GPA for second through fourth years, earn 30 credits per year, and be continuously enrolled in a four-year degree program.
